

LOWER SCHOOL DRESS CODE

As we continue to transition to our Lands' End provider, students may continue to wear their red polo shirts for one more year as long as their uniforms meet the neat, clean and appropriately sized criteria.

Any special events or field trips that deviate from the normal dress code will be determined by the teacher and/or the administration. All decisions by the faculty and/or administration concerning dress code are final.

All new shirts must have the Bayshore logo and must be purchased from Lands' End . Bottoms may be purchased at Lands' End or at any store, as long as they conform to uniform standards. Logos are not required on uniform bottoms. "Spirit wear" shirts and sweatshirts may be purchased in the School Store. "Spirit wear" shirts may be worn on Tuesdays. Outerwear must be purchased from Lands' End or the School Store. Lands' End orders may be placed at www.landsend.com/school or by calling 1.800.469.2222. Our Preferred School Number is 900132077.

Grades K2 and K3

Shirts: Burgundy t-shirt with the Bayshore iron-on logo (provided by Lands' End) or classic red Bayshore t-shirt *.

Bottoms: Pull-up navy knit or twill shorts or navy sweat pants, or navy knit skorts.

Outerwear for K2, K3, and K4 : Zippered or buttoned front sweater or jacket.

Grades K4 through 5th

Shirts: Burgundy or maize interlock or mesh polo shirt, long or short sleeved, or classic red polo *.

Bottoms: Navy plain or pleated front chino pants or shorts, or chino stretch or knit skort.

Outerwear: With the exception of K4, zippered front sweatshirt in burgundy or navy; drifter zip-front or drifter, fine gauge or cable-button front cardigan sweater, polar fleece jacket or vest, zip-front hooded cardigan, in burgundy, navy or maize. (Visit the Lands'End website to see choices. Also, visit the School Store for "spirit wear" outerwear choices which are acceptable for "everyday" apparel.)

** Please note that the classic red polo and t-shirts are being phased out over the next year, and cannot be ordered from Lands' End.*

Accessories

Belt: If an article of clothing has belt loops a belt must be worn, however no belts for K2-K4.

Shoes: Shoes must look good with the uniform. Clean, attractive sneakers must be worn by preschool and elementary students.

Special Occasions: On special occasions such as picture day, athletic team game days,

field trips, holidays, school spirit days, and any other designated days, administration may allow for students to depart from their daily uniform. Administration/faculty will inform students and parents of the dress that is appropriate for special occasions. All decisions by the administration and faculty regarding special occasion dress code days are final.

T-shirt Tuesdays: On Tuesdays all students may wear BCS spirit t-shirts purchased in the school store with the daily uniform bottom. Shirts must be appropriate in size, in good condition and tucked in.

Hair: Students' hair is expected to be neat, combed, clean and out of their eyes. Fad or extreme hair styles, such as mohawks or dreadlocks, and dyed or unnatural hair coloring are not permitted. Boys' hair is to be neatly trimmed; the back not longer than above the collar of their shirts.

Other: Sunglasses or hats of any type are not to be worn on campus prior to 3:30 p.m. Hats must not have any inappropriate wording or symbols. Rags, cloths, knit caps and any other head covers are not permitted at any time.

UPPER SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Our desire with our dress code is for our school to be distinctly different from other schools. Administration has the right and responsibility to require all students to be appropriately dressed before attending any class.

Any special events or field trips that deviate from the normal dress code will be determined by the teacher and/or the administration. All decisions by the faculty and/or administration concerning dress code are final.

All new shirts must have the Bayshore logo and must be purchased from Lands' End or the School Store. Shirts with the "warrior" logo may still be worn as long as they are the correct color for the grade level.

Uniform bottoms may be purchased at Lands' End, George Schoolwear at www.walmart.com, school uniforms at www.target.com or at any store which stocks **school uniforms**, and must conform to Bayshore **uniform standard** for length, style, material and fit. Logos are not required on uniform bottoms.

"Spirit wear" shirts and sweatshirts may be purchased in the School Store. "Spirit wear" shirts may be worn on Tuesdays. Outerwear must be purchased from Lands' End or the School Store. Lands' End orders may be placed at www.landsend.com/school or by calling 1.800.469.2222. Our Preferred School Number is 900132077.

Middle School (Grades 6 – 8)

Shirts: Navy or maize interlock or mesh polo shirt, long or short sleeved, standard or feminine fit. Both the new “shield” logos and the “warrior” logos are permitted. Boys’ shirttails must be completely tucked in. Undershirts, camisoles, or any other undergarments, may not be visible below the hemline of the polo shirts.

Bottoms: Khaki-colored plain or pleated-front **uniform** slacks or knee-length shorts, for both girls and boys. Girls may also wear **uniform** “capri” slacks (available through George Schoolwear at walmart.com and also at target.com school uniforms), “skimmers” (available through George Schoolwear at walmart.com) and “crop” pants (available at landsend.com/school). **Skirts and skorts are no longer part of the approved dress code.**

Outerwear: Zippered front sweat shirt in burgundy or navy; drifter zip-front or drifter, fine gauge or cable-button front cardigan sweater, polar fleece jacket or vest, zip-front hooded cardigan, in burgundy, navy or maize. A uniform polo shirt must be worn underneath all outerwear. (Visit the Lands’ End website to see choices. Also, visit the School Store for “spirit wear” outerwear choices which are acceptable for “everyday” apparel.)

Physical Education Apparel : Grey t-shirt with Bayshore iron-on logo, burgundy athletic-length shorts, and sneakers.

High School (Grades 9 – 12)

Shirts: Burgundy or white interlock or mesh polo shirt, long or short sleeved, standard or feminine fit. Both the new “shield” logos and the “warrior” logos are permitted. Boys’ shirttails must be completely tucked in. Undershirts, camisoles, or any other undergarments, may not be visible below the hemline of the polo shirts.

Bottoms: same as Middle School.

Outerwear: same as Middle School.

Physical Education Apparel: same as Middle School.

Accessories

Belt: If an article of clothing has belt loops, a belt must be worn.

Shoes: All shoes must be closed toe and closed heel.

Special Occasions: On special occasions such as picture day, athletic team game days, field trips, holidays, school spirit days, and any other designated days administration may allow for students to depart from their daily uniform. Administration/faculty will inform students and parents of the dress that is appropriate for special occasions. All decisions by the administration and faculty regarding special occasion dress code days are final. Students are expected to make choices that are modest and appropriate for young Christian men and women.

T-Shirt Tuesdays: On Tuesdays all students may wear BCS spirit t-shirts purchased in the School Store with the daily uniform bottom. Shirts must be appropriate in size, in

good condition and tucked in.

Jeans Days: A “jeans day” pass allows the student to wear jeans with a Bayshore uniform shirt, or only on T-Shirt Tuesdays, a BCS spirit t-shirt. The pass must be presented to the homeroom teacher on the day it is being used.

Hair Code: Student’s hair is expected to be neat, combed, clean and out of their eyes. Fad or extreme hair styles, such as mohawks or dreadlocks, or unnatural coloring are not permitted. Boy’s hair is to be neatly trimmed with the back above the collar of their shirt. Male students are expected to be clean shaven.

Jewelry, Piercing and Tattoos: Jewelry may not be excessively large or distracting. The following symbols are not permitted: zodiac, yin-yang, peace symbol, skull/crossbones, spikes or cult symbols. All decisions by the administration and faculty regarding appropriate jewelry are final. Tongue rings and “body piercing” are not permitted. Girls may wear earrings following the jewelry guidelines. Male students may not wear earrings at anytime on BCS campus or to any BCS function. Absolutely no exposed temporary or permanent tattoos are permitted. If a student has a tattoo it must be covered at all times.

Elective Class Attire: Elective classes that require dress other than the school daily uniform must meet with the approval of the faculty member in charge and administration.

After-School Clothing: Students changing into casual clothes after school must follow these guidelines:

Athletic team practices – coach and administration approved practice uniform or clothing.

Other “non-team” casual clothing – BCS PE shorts or shorts of the same length and same loose fitting style. Shirts must have sleeves.

Other: Sunglasses or hats of any type are not to be worn on campus prior to 3:30 p.m. Hats must not have any inappropriate wording or symbols. Rags, cloths, knit caps and any other head covers are not permitted at any time.
