CRAFT FAIR - - ATTENTION "CRAFTERS"!

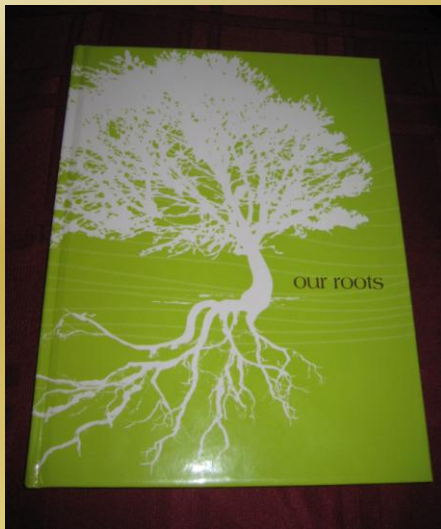

National Day of Prayer & Remembrance



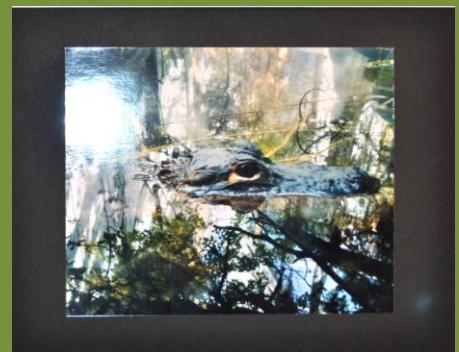
2011 YEARBOOKS HONORED!
