Last week, prior to the start of spring break, we communicated with our BCS community school closure with remote (online) learning through the week of March 23<sup>rd</sup>. As many of you have heard, our state Governor Ron DeSantis has given a directive for all schools to close through April 15<sup>th</sup>, when the COVID19 situation will be reassessed.
