Subject: Important Camp Bayshore 2020 Information and Update

Camp Bayshore Families,

On behalf of Bayshore Christian School Administration and myself, we pray each of you are healthy and safe during these unprecedented times.

Currently, we are moving forward with Camp Bayshore 2020 and are set to open as scheduled; however, we will be complying with all guidelines and regulations set by the CDC and our local government. The safety and health of our campers, campers' families, and staff are of the utmost importance. We are restructuring our protocol and rescheduling our plans to ensure all campers have a safe and fun place to go this summer.

At this time and until further notice, the following guidelines and regulations will be applied to Camp Bayshore 2020:

- There will be a 9:1 camper/staff ratio to guarantee we are under the 10-person guideline suggested by the CDC. Each group will remain together throughout the day to alleviate any potential risk of cross contamination.
- We will be limiting the number of individuals on campus to only Bayshore Christian School and Camp Bayshore employees. Camper drop off and pick up will take place outside via a drive-thru procedure. Parents and/or any other adults will not be permitted to leave their vehicles. We will still require adults to present ID to confirm they are on the designated pick up list before they can take a camper home. Please login to your Parent Portal to ensure pick up information is current.
- Before entering our campus, all campers' temperature will be taken daily with a non-contact forehead thermometer. If any camper has a fever of 100.4 or higher, they will not be permitted to attend.
- All children will be required to sanitize their hands upon arriving at Camp and throughout the day, specifically before and after they engage with any Camp Bayshore supplies.
- Camp Bayshore facilities will be cleaned and sanitized daily, as well as all supplies.
- Each group will have their own supplies to use during each week, so there will be no communal sharing.
- All field trips are cancelled until further notice. While we understand field trips are an integral part of the Camp Bayshore experience, safety comes first. We will be adding various activities and experiences daily to assist in replacing that time.
- All families must complete additional forms that will be uploaded to the Parent Portal on CampSite and submit all current physical and immunization records. You will be notified when these additional forms are uploaded. This must be completed before a camper can attend Camp.
- If a child develops symptoms, they will be isolated and must be picked up immediately. There will be a strict return policy. The camper must be tested, and results must be communicated. If a child tests negative, they may not return to Camp until they are fever-free without the aid of medicine for 72 hours.
- If a camper or staff member tests positive, the CDC will be notified and has the right to close Camp for an average of 2 – 5 days or for its entirety.

Due to these changes to comply with CDC and local government guidelines, Camp Bayshore operating hours may be adjusted. We will communicate that information with you immediately if that change is made.

This is not our typical summer, and we understand this is different from originally planned. Camp Bayshore is working diligently to provide a quality program for your family given our current situation. Please remember that plans could change at any moment and know that we will communicate that with you as soon as possible.

Whether this is your first summer with us or you are returning, we are beyond thankful that you entrust us with your children. It is a blessing and a task we do not take lightly.

Camp Bayshore will communicate all information and/or changes as they become available. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me. I am happy to help.
