Job Description

As the Varsity Boys Basketball Coach your role will involve coaching, character and spiritual development, and providing direction to student athletes so that they might achieve a high level of skill as well as an appreciation for discipline, sportsmanship and teamwork in basketball. The ideal candidate should possess strong leadership abilities, communication skills, and the ability to motivate and inspire others. This position requires effective communication and collaboration with administration, athletes, and parents. Join us in providing a safe and well-maintained environment for our students and staff to thrive.

Job Responsibilities

- Plan and lead practices focused on skill development, strategy, and conditioning
- Establish performance criteria for competition and evaluate students' athletic abilities initially and on a regular basis.
- Effectively communicate each athlete's progress to the athlete and parents where appropriate.
- Promote and assist with fundraising efforts.
- Assist with administrative matters relating to the team.
- Responsible for keeping team and individual statistics posted and current
- Checks and secures all locker rooms, gym, outside doors and all lights after last player leaves after games and practices.
- Supervises the team after school on game days as well as travels to and from away games and other basketball events. Ability to drive school van.
- Consults with the Athletic Director regarding any off-season training programs including scheduling dates for summer camps and clinics.
- Responsible for daily cleaning of the gym floor prior to practice and games.
- Attend all practices and team events such as games, meetings, end of season sports banquet, social events, etc. Responsible for all games and tournament entries in a timely manner.

- Provides a plan for vertical alignment with the TBCAL basketball teams as well as off-season improvement plan for all members of the varsity boys' basketball program.
- Attends athletic staff development meetings, clinics and other professional activities to improve coaching performance.
