Bayshore Christian School is working diligently to adhere to all CDC and local government guidelines to ensure your student has a safe school year. Throughout the year, we will be: promoting healthy hygiene practices such as hand washing and employees wearing a face mask, as feasible; intensifying cleaning, disinfection, and ventilation of facilities; encouraging social distancing through increased spacing, small groups (when practicable), and limited mixing between divisions; staggering scheduling, arrival, and drop off; adjusting activities and transitions to limit sharing of items such as toys, belongings, supplies, and equipment; and training all employees on health and safety protocols.

Due to the current pandemic and CDC and local government guidelines, I agree to the following terms of condition:

1. If a student is displaying signs of illness, the student will stay home.
2. All students, especially those with underlying medical conditions, are vulnerable. By attending Bayshore Christian School, family voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.
3. Students will be screened for symptoms listed by the CDC (cough, shortness of breath or difficulty of breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, and/or loss of taste or smell) and will have their temperature taken daily upon arrival (and possible random temperature checks throughout the school day). If symptoms or a temperature above 100.4 are detected, the student will not be allowed to stay at school and must adhere to contents of number 4 below.
4. If a student develops a fever of 100.4 or higher or shows signs of any symptoms listed by the CDC at least 48 hours prior to attending class, family will notify the school office, Administrative Assistant: Sarah Lockhart immediately, and the student will not be able to return until they are fever-free without the use of fever reducing medicine for 72 hours. In addition, the family must provide a note from a doctor that the student is cleared to return.
5. If the family travels to an area with substantial spread or is exposed to someone who has or may have been exposed to COVID-19, the family must notify Sarah Lockhart, Administrative Assistant, immediately and will not return to Bayshore Christian School until a two-week self-quarantine is complete.
