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Below you will find the information that pertains to our class and for your child’s learning. I know and understand you have received a lot of information. We will take this one day at a time and please email any time with questions and problems you’re experiencing. This is a new process for me too and I will need feedback, especially if something doesn’t work for your child. I will make the necessary adjustments. However, please keep in mind that I'm meeting the needs of 12 students (and parents). Flexibility is key for all of us and it will make this process go smoothly.

Here is a general schedule that I thought would be helpful to keep the students organized and focused. The order of the lessons is optional however the students are familiar with this schedule.

FACTS SIS (Renweb): Let me know ASAP if you cannot access FACTS-SIS or view the lesson plans!

You must log in daily into FACTS-SIS for Morning and afternoon ATTENDANCE, LESSONS, AND CLASS ANNOUNCEMENTS/INFORMATION. There will be very detailed lesson plans for all subjects. Some assignments will use web-based resources, utilize textbooks and workbook pages, and some assignments with documents provided online. Please let me know if you don't have access to a printer.

Please be sure to review the specific time provided by Mrs. Humenansky for picking up your child's Chromebook and learning materials needed for the next few weeks. The good news is that your child has already been shown how to access multiple resources on his/her Chromebook. The lessons for Monday are based on the materials I've already provided in the envelope sent home on Friday, March 13th. (It's now time to open the package 😊!)

Assignment Requirements and How to Submit Assignments:

Web-based assignments may not require something to be "turned in" such as sites like Xtramath, Quizlet, and Spelling City. Some web-based assignments will have a completion requirement within the lesson such as ConnectEd (Wonders), Nearpod or Zearn (a new website we will learn to use this week). However, there will be assignments that must be physically turned in (for subjects like Bible, Math, Cursive, and Writing). For this process, we are asking that you submit these assignments via email attachment or a shared document on Office 365 (Microsoft Outlook/OneDrive folders).

Based on the Lesson Plan information in FACTS-SIS (for each subject) all assignments required on a particular day of the week **must be turned in by 7:30 pm in order to receive full credit. If an issue arises and you are unable to submit an assignment on time, please let me know via email BEFORE 7:30 pm deadline.**

When attaching the completed documents via email, please send it with your student's name, date and title of assignments (example: Eva – Bible, Math and Cursive 3-23-2020). Please attach all documents to one email and send when all are completed, instead of several emails throughout the day. This may be modified in the future – your feedback is appreciated!

Please remember to email me for any questions, concerns, if you're confused, or need support in any way for your child or your family! I'm in constant prayers for you all. I already miss everyone's little faces. Please feel free to communicate with each other through Class Dojo with pictures and messages of encouragement. Unfortunately, you will not be able to communicate with me through there. Reminder that for the safety of all our families – please do not share any posts on social media from class dojo. This would be a fun way for our class and students to stay connected. I will be in touch throughout the week as I continue to learn how to use the resources, we have to enhance your child's learning experience.
